The 2017 International Chemical Recovery Conference, hosted by PAPTAC, is held every three years and is the preeminent conference in the area of chemical recovery technology. Approximately 70 papers will be presented and the attendees come from all major pulp producing countries. To round out the conference, we are inviting you to submit a poster for a dedicated poster session.

In this era of increasing efficiency concerns, sustainability and energy optimization, the theme for the 2017 conference will be “Pulp mills and biorefineries, a world of growth in chemical recovery cycle.” The conference will focus on improving thermal and process efficiency, maximizing steam and power generation from black liquor and biomass, controlling fouling, evaluating new technologies, and showcasing successful solutions. In addition to papers from all areas of chemical recovery, this conference will feature a keynote session with invited speakers, daily topical panel discussions, and a stimulating social program.

We encourage you to submit non-commercial posters on the following topics:

- Ash treatment for chloride/potassium removal
- Black liquor combustion
- Corrosion in recovery process equipment
- Energy efficiency and steam savings

- Increasing biomass use in power boilers
- Integrated forest biorefinery development
- Lime kilns - reducing fossil energy and problem solving
- Maximizing self-generated power
- NCG systems and experiences
- Recovery boiler emissions
- Recovery boiler fouling
- Sulfite pulping chemicals recovery
- XL Recovery Boilers
- Bioenergy, biomaterials and biotechnologies associated with chemical recovery cycle.

Authors interested in presenting a poster on these or related topics must submit a draft of their poster on-line at: admin@paptac.ca by March 31, 2017. Posters should focus on a single topic and be prepared according to the following guidelines.

POSTER CONTENT:

The contents of the poster should be clear, concise and geared towards a mainly non-academic audience. The material presented must not be primarily commercial or intended to advertise a product or violate anti-trust guidelines. "If in doubt, leave it out."

POSTER DIMENSIONS:

The structure height is 7'10" however the **poster surface area** (where you will actually pin your poster) is 7'7" x 3'9", (91" wide x 45" high / 231 cm x 114 cm). In order to accommodate all the posters received, please respect the poster size requirement! Please see picture below. Velcro tabs or pushpins will be provided on site.

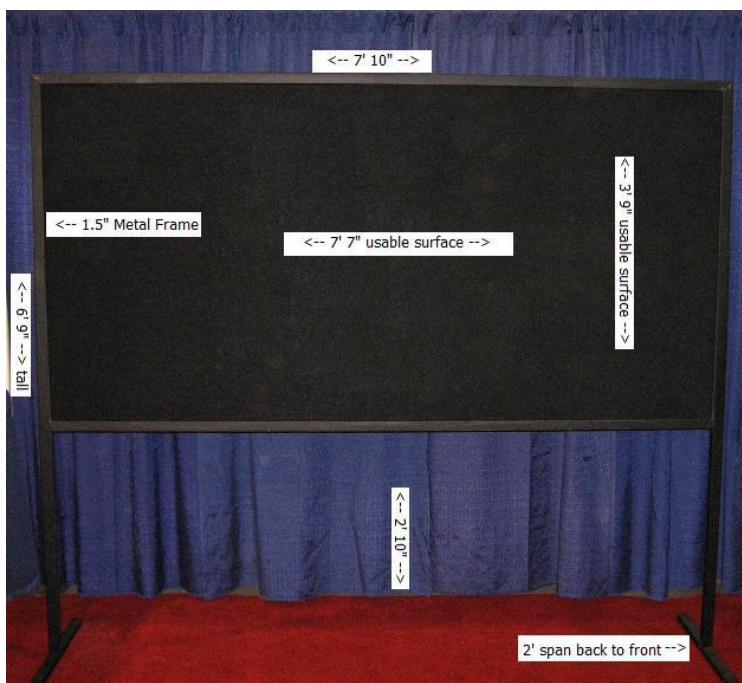
PRESENCE AT YOUR POST:

The poster session will be on Wednesday May 24th, 2017 during the conference's Welcoming Reception. Authors must be present in order for the posters to be displayed.

Posters will also remain on display all of the following day, Thursday May 25th.

Posters must be manned the entire time during the Welcoming Reception, Wednesday May 24th, but only at coffee breaks during the day of Thursday May 25th. Please refer to the conference program for precise times.

Poster authors will be notified of acceptance by April 15, 2017. A review of the posters will be conducted prior to the conference for recommendations, if needed.
